3. SR 100 Half Facepiece Airline Respirator. Blue Silicone, two sizes

All models incorporated the Sundstrom SR307 airline regulator and belt, with any one of the following SEA Breathing Hoses:

- (i) Compressed Air Hose PVC 13 mm ID.
- (ii) Compressed Air Hose Rubber 13 mm ID.
- (iii) Compressed Air Hose Rubber 10 mm ID.

These Breathing Hoses are Approved for use with the above apparatus, up to 90 metres in length, utilising up to three CEJN couplings.

Approved as complying with AS/NZS 1716-1994, "Respiratory protective devices", including Clause 2.1.9, "Protection from flame", as airline respirators subject to the following conditions:
